The school district provides student email accounts accessible from any Internet-connected computer, subject to age-appropriateness and budgetary considerations. Students may use their accounts for non-school-related purposes. Access to other email accounts is not allowed on campus without specific consent of a staff member.

Email communication is an important skill for students to develop in an environment safe from Internet predators, inappropriate content and cyber-bullying. All incoming and outgoing email to student accounts is filtered for inappropriate text and pictures. Questionable emails are held for review by a faculty member who will determine whether they are appropriate for delivery. Note that students taking online classes will generally need to be able to exchange emails with teachers and students outside of the school district. Access levels can be changed by submitting a new form. Levels of access are listed below. Please darken the circle of the email access level appropriate for the student.

Garden Valley School District reserves the right to impose email restrictions or revoke email access entirely if the student does not comply with the usage guidelines in district policy. Parents may check the email their child has sent or received, but may not send emails from their children's accounts
