This event is like a jog-a-thon, except your child(ren) will be reading books instead of running laps and have the option of earning pledges based on how much they read. Everything is tracked online, which makes inviting sponsors and logging reading much easier! Our school goal this year is to read 200,000 minutes.

Your child will receive a private online account at <https://www.whooosreading.org/> where he/she will log reading minutes. Your child will not be able to invite any sponsors without your authorization. Prior to the start date the parent listed as primary email address in Oncourse will receive an email from Whooo's Reading with your child's specific log-in information. If you do not receive an email, please check your spam folder. The parent listed as the primary email can add another email as well to view your child's progress.


