

Proof of Residency Information

Proof of Residency

Students must be residents of the state of South Carolina.

All students must provide proof of residency annually:

- Two (2) recent (within the last 30 days) proofs of residency (see list below)
One must be a primary proof of residency (see list below)
- Proof of Residency will be required annually during the Intent to Return process

Living with a Homeowner or Renter (meaning: the parent/guardian of the student/s do not have a primary proof in their name):

- ◆ If the parent/guardian registering the student does not own the home, you must provide:
 - Two (2) recent (within the past 30 days) proofs of residence (one must be a Primary Proof) from the home owner (see list below), **and**
 - Copy of the parent/guardian Driver's License/ID **and**
 - The Affidavit of Residency form – this form must be notarized.
 - If the parent/guardian cannot provide two (2) proofs of residency at the time of registration, he/she will have **30 days** from the date of registration to provide those two (2) proofs to the school.

New Home or Rental Agreement:

If you are in the process of building a new home you must provide:

- A signed contract with a closing date that is at least 8 weeks out from the date you register for school, **and**
- A copy of your Driver's License/ID, **and**
- Once you are moved into your new home, you must provide a utility bill to the school.

Acceptable Proofs of Residency Include:

Primary Proofs	Secondary Proofs
◆ Utility Bill (power bill, water bill, cable bill)	◆ Cell phone bill
◆ Mortgage Statement	◆ Medical billing
◆ Insurance on the home	◆ Check stub
◆ Signed Lease Agreement	◆ SC State issued license or ID
