### **For those students interested in applying:**

- ✓ You must have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA
- ✓ You must be applying to an accredited institution of high learning, including technical or vocational colleges, business schools or beauty colleges. There are no restrictions on the area of study for post-graduate schooling.
- ✓ All applications must be typed, spell checked and neat to be considered for a scholarship. Applicants must completely answer all questions provided on page 2 of this document.
- ✓ Students who receive scholarships will be required to give proof of post-high school enrollment to the Scholarship Fund Committee BEFORE they receive money.
- ✓ Students who receive scholarships will be required to send a thank you note to the Scholarship Fund Committee BEFORE they receive money. These thank you notes need to be received within 30 days of graduation and include your return address.
