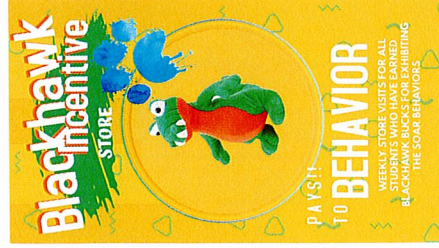
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Discipline=Teaching

was geared toward students. To motivate students, the Blackhawk buck store was open to students to support their classroom reward system for positive behavior. Students always looked forward to spending their bucks in the store.

The Blackhawk Student of the Month

Assembly this year had a primary focus on selecting the student that exhibits Social Emotional attribute of the month. Social Emotional Learning (SEL) happens at the start of each day. Creative, interactive SEL lessons are incorporated into daily morning lessons by all instructional teachers.



We have a stellar reading intervention team that is comprised of 2 retired teachers, 1 Reading Assistant and a full-time Reading Specialist. This team helps support our reading intervention model, which ensures that EVERY Blackhawk student receives a small group intervention/enrichment time slot for 2-3 days a week both inside and out of the general classroom.



Read, Lead, Succeed!

Reading is a top priority in many ways. In our school, we demonstrate this by:



- Implementing effective instruction as evidenced by grade levels K-3rd realizing over 50% average student EOY growth for each class. In 3rd the average percent progress towards Typical Growth is 81% and 101% for both grades respectively.

Making Math Matter!

At Blackhawk Primary Center we strive to make math matter. We demonstrate this by:

- Engaging students with a rigorous math curriculum that focuses on a deep understanding of mathematical concepts.
- Scheduling 90 minutes of daily math instruction as well as a math intervention/enrichment three days a week.



- Offering a school-wide fact fluency initiative centered on the foundational fluency skills for each grade level. Students participate in monthly fact fluency battles and students are rewarded for their achievements.
- Achieving significant growth in ready, all grade levels improved. Students Approaching to Meeting on Ready by grade level and class are Kindergarten 100%, 1st Grade 80%/95%, 2nd grade 78%/71%, and 3rd grade 95%/95%.
