**High School Senior** - a transcript from your high school that details your scholastic record, grades attained and class ranking and scores attained on the ACT or SAT

Submit your application to the High School Guidance Counselor. The Guidance Counselor is responsible for submitting a packet of scholarship applications to the Selection Committee. Prior to August 1 the recipient shall notify the Selection Committee as to the school which the student will be attending and the address where the scholarship check should be mailed to the school. Prior to disbursement of the scholarship check, the recipient must agree to sign a statement authorizing the Selection Committee to communicate with the school of the recipient's choice and to obtain information from the school's files regarding the student's enrollment in the school, the use of the scholarship funds sent to the school by the Selection Committee and the student's scholastic record.
