### Horatio Alger Scholarship

To be eligible to apply for the Horatio Alger Scholarship Programs, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled full-time as a high school senior in the United States, progressing normally toward graduation in spring/summer of 2020 with plans to enter a college in the United States no later than the fall following graduation
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a **bachelor's degree** at an accredited non-profit public or private institution in the United States (students may start their studies at a two-year institution and then transfer to a four-year institution)
- Demonstrate critical financial need (\$55,000 or lower adjusted gross family income is required)
- Be involved in co-curricular and community service activities
- Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Maintain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0
- Be a United States citizen

#### Jack Kent Cooke College Scholarship Program

To be eligible for the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program, applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- **Senior standing** Plan to graduate from a U.S. high school in spring 2020.
- **Fall College Enrollment** Intend to enroll in an accredited four-year college beginning in fall 2018
- **GPA** Earn a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.5 or above.
- **Test Scores** Receive standardized test scores in the top 15%: SAT combined critical reading and math score of 1200 or above and/or ACT composite score of 26 or above.
- **Income** Demonstrate significant unmet financial need. The foundation will consider applicants with family income up to \$95,000. However, we anticipate that a majority of scholarship recipients will be eligible to receive a Pell grant.

### SWCS Scholarship: Show-Me Chapter, Soil and Water Conservation Society

The SWCS Scholarship provides financial assistance to students wishing to pursue studies with a natural resource conservation orientation at properly accredited colleges or universities. One \$2000 scholarship will be awarded, with the possibility of a second, smaller scholarship. Scholarship recipients also receive a complimentary one-year membership in SWCS and the local chapter. Eligibility: This scholarship is for students who attend/graduated from an approved program of study in Missouri (as stated in Missouri statute, RSMO 167.031 - includes public, private, and home school).
