ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Student must be a resident of Osceola County at time of High School Graduation.
- 2) Student should be a graduating senior with a minimum of a 2.0 Grade Point Average.
- 3) Student must be pursuing a degree in Conservation, Natural Resources, Environmental Studies, or Agriculture at an accredited institution of Higher Education. Preference will be given to those pursuing a conservation related degree.
- 4) Student must demonstrate participation in extra-curricular activities.
- 5) Student must demonstrate a passion for conservation and related activities.
- 6) One Letter of Recommendation must be attached to the application.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1) Applicants must submit completed applications to the High School Guidance Counselor's Office by **April 9, 2021**.
- 2) Members of the Osceola County Conservation Board will review the submitted applications and chose one successful applicant to receive a \$1000.00 scholarship after successfully completing the first year of college in your indicated area of study.
- 3) The Osceola County Conservation Board will work with the School to notify the successful applicant.

PRESENTATION

A representative of the Osceola County Conservation Board will present the Scholarship at the Schools Awards Day.
