HOW DOES SCHOOL-BASED TELEMEDICINE WORK?



With a parent's permission, the student will be evaluated by an ARcare provider through a secure video connection. With the assistance of a school nurse, and the use of special equipment, our provider can listen to a patient's heart and lungs and examine their ears, throat and eyes. Once the assessment is complete, a summary of the visit and instructions for follow-up care is given to the parent.
