- This will be a pass/fail course and will provide a student/parent evaluation
- ✓ Students are issued a problem that they must design a solution, test their solution, tweak, and test again.
- ✓ This program will help student understand the basics of engineering and becoming more innovative.
- ✓ STEM camp will continued to offered to 5th grade students entering the 6th grade
- ✓ He is working with Christie Hoffman to develop a "makers space" in the library
- This programming will provide career readiness for students
- ✓ With the implementaiton of the STEM program, Mr. Ferrell will continue to teach 6th grade science.
- ✓ Mr. Lichty noted this is a great program for Hicksville Schools to implement, and hopes neighboring districts will model themselves after Hicksville.
- ❖ Stephanie Mazur hopes this new program will interest more girls to go into engineering.
- Craig Eiden praised Mr. Ferrell for his passion for teaching.
