The meeting was opened by President Stephanie Mazur with Board members Jennifer Caryer, Craig Eiden, Minda Jones, Stephanie Mazur, and Dennis Vetter present.

#### **AGENDA**

#### Finance Committee

- ✓ There was discussion of forming a "Finance Committee" to help watch the finances of the district.
  - Comprised of two (2) Board members, and three (3) Community Members

### <u>Levy</u>

✓ Discussed waiting until next May's forecast to determine the need to place a levy on the ballot for the fall.

### Land Sale

- ✓ Bruce Guilford recommended waiting until spring to sell the Arthur Street property.
  - May preface "stick built" homes only.

#### CRA Project

- ✓ "CRA" stands for the "Community Renewal Act"
- ✓ Jerry Hayes of the Defiance County Economic Development office will be present at the November 27<sup>th</sup> meeting to discuss the project.
- ✓ The Act basically allows the District to give a seven (7) year tax abatement (up to 75%) to individuals/businesses either constructing new homes/buildings, or making improvements to existing structures.

#### School Calendar

- ✓ Discussed starting school by roughly August 14, 2018 for the 2018-2019 school year.
- ✓ This would provide six (6) valuable "teaching days" before state testing begins.
- ✓ Also, the plan is to eliminate three (3) In-Service days and change those to 2-hour delays.
- ✓ School would then let out by the end of May, and moving graduation up by a week.
- ✓ This would also place the District on the same starting schedule as IEC and Four County.
- ✓ There would be three (3) teaching days the first week, three (3) the second week, and then a regular five (5) day instruction week.

## **Extending Drive to State Route 18**

- ✓ Discussed the construction of a road over to State Route 18 to alleviate traffic flow during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up.
- ✓ A suggestion was made to install an arch over the entrance of the drive at both ends to prohibit oversized traffic from utilizing the drive.

## Open House

✓ An 10-year Anniversary Open House will be scheduled for sometime in October/November 2018.

## School Activities

- ✓ Jennifer Caryer inquired of the percentage of free/reduced lunch students that participate in after school activities and/or class trips.
- ✓ Her concern is the cost of some activities turns some students away from participating.
