Re: Community Update - Vaccinations and Schedule for March 1st - March 5th

Greetings Barneveld Families,

We were informed yesterday afternoon that vaccinations are now available for the next group eligible under the DHS guidelines ([link](#)) under subgroup 1B. Due to the limited availability of the vaccine, this process will take several weeks from start to finish. This will require the district to be flexible with regard to scheduling. The first round of vaccines is scheduled to begin on Thursday and Friday of next week (March 4th and 5th). The vaccination clinic is off-site and will require staff to travel back and forth for specifically designated times. Because of this, we are adjusting our schedule for next week.

Week of March 1st - March 5th:

Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday will be full days of **in-person** instruction for ALL grade levels (virtual students will still remain virtual). Thursday and Friday will be **full virtual** for all students. The teachers will communicate with families as it relates to how each day will operate. We understand that this will be a challenge and we are doing everything we can to provide as much in-person instruction as possible.

Our collective efforts have enabled us to continue providing valuable learning experiences for our students and your continued support is truly appreciated. We are getting closer to a point where we can return to "normal" and I encourage you to continue helping this process by practicing social distancing, wearing face coverings, and healthy hand hygiene.
