The Hagan M. Hix Memorial Scholarship

1. Deadline for scholarship application is **March 15** and must be turned into your school counseling center. (No Exceptions)

NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration as a **SOPHOMORE in good standing** with an accredited post-secondary institution. If the student is attending a technical school, the funds will be awarded upon evidence of registration as a current student. You will need to provide this information to Mrs. Kim Hix or Mr. Tony Boles.

Description: The *Hagan M. Hix Scholarship* fund was established in June, 2011 upon Hagan's death at the age of 19. His family developed the fund to honor his memory by giving a scholarship to a deserving student in order to continue Hagan's strong desire to always help others. Hagan did not graduate at the top, nor was he the most popular, but he was an exceptional student and person. He was honest and strong willed with a tremendous work ethic and dedication to all. Clubs and community service was important to Hagan because of his interest in people, not because of any self gain. Hagan had a genuine love for people and visited as many as he could. He would have been a sophomore at the University of Tennessee in the fall of 2011. Therefore, the goal and purpose of the LIVESTRONG scholarship committee is to give a **\$1,000.00** scholarship to a student who exhibits similar characteristics to Hagan and who will begin their sophomore year in good standing at a postsecondary institution.

Criteria:

1. The applicant must be enrolled at a high school within the Macon County School District.
2. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
3. The applicant must be a U.S. Citizen.
4. The applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or higher based on a 4.0 Scale.

Application Process

The applicant must submit the following items **TYPED**:

1. Completed application form (may be downloaded at www.redboilingspringsschool.com).
2. A letter of application addressed to the scholarship committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation of the career goals and personal (background) information.
3. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/rank.
4. A personal essay of 300 words or less. In your essay, please answer the question on the enclosed essay form. ***"What does LIVESTRONG mean to you and how does your life exemplify this character trait?"***

DEADLINE: Please return the application and all necessary forms to your school counseling center by **March 15**

Award: If awarded the scholarship, you will be presented with an award at your school's awards night activities. The award winner may also be asked to attend an interview with the scholarship committee.
