

NCPS COVID19 Screening Procedure

For bus pick up and car rider drop off

In order for a student to enter the bus or school their temperature needs to read below 99.5 and have no complaints of any ill feeling symptoms.

An additional screening checklist for COVID19 symptoms will be asked for students with temperatures between 99.6F and 100.3F. If all symptom questions are NO the student will be permitted to attend school. If any symptom question is answered yes the student will be asked to stay home and follow the after illness return to school protocol.

For any student with a temperature of 100.4F or higher will be asked to stay home and not to return to school until they are fever free for 24hours without the use of fever reducing medications such as Tylenol and Ibuprofen

For any student experiencing COVID19 related symptoms without a fever that have no known medical history such as asthma, headaches, allergies, etc are also asked to stay home until the symptom has resolved or a medical diagnosis has been made with a supporting doctors note that it is safe to attend school.

Mid-Day Temperature Checks

A fever will stand at the temperature of 100.4F or higher. Any student who has a reading of 100.4F on an infrared thermometer will have it confirmed with an oral thermometer. If the oral thermometer also reads 100.4F or Higher the student will be asked to wait in the clinic waiting room while a parent is notified to pick up. That student will not be allowed to return to school until they have been fever free for 24hours without the use of fever reducing medication such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen

An additional screening checklist for COVID19 symptoms will be asked for students with temperatures between 99.6F and 100.3F. If all symptom questions are NO the student will be permitted to stay at school with parent notification and option to pick up if parent chooses to do so. If any symptom question is answered yes the student will be asked to wait in the clinic waiting room while a parent is contacted to pick up and follow the after illness return to school protocol.

If the oral thermometer reads normal between 98.6F and 99.5F the student will be permitted to stay in school as long as they have no other complaints of any COVID19 related symptoms.
