Under the new and exciting run, gun and crash the boards type of game at Brewer, the Junior Varsity lived up to that type of game. The team accomplished many achievements:



The Bi-centennial Minute

On May 13th, 1776, two-hundred years ago today in a pub in Boston, Tories danced to "Yankee Doodle."

Two-hundred years ago today, at a drinking "frolic" in a Boston public house, a subject loyal to the crown forgot his caution. The Tory raised his glass to the King's success, and was immediately attacked and dragged off to the guards. They duly passed sentence, and he was forced to dance to the tune of "Yankee Doodle" in a hogshead until the next day.

Tory colonists, stranded, apart from their Mother-England, were the victims of cruel persecution. Despised and exiled, they were prisoners of their own belief.

On May 2, 1776, two-hundred years ago today, French secret aid began.

Two-hundred years ago today, Roderique Hortalez and Company, a fictitious compnay, was set up to supply the American colonies with badly needed munitions in the guise of ordinary cargo. The American stand for freedom had aroused the warmest sympathy amongst the French, but any aid to the colonies would have to be given cladestinely to avoid the wrath of the British government. To direct this operation was to be primarily the work on one man, secret agent Pierre de Beaumarchais. A man of great optimism, he engineered such a clever strategy that the English court was completely deceived.

During the course of the war, a million livres' worth of munition was supplied to Americans through this ficititious company, thus contributing a vital role in America's revolution.








Pulp And Paper

The Chemical Engineering program I, Bill Igoe, attended this summer was entitled "Selected Topics In Chemical Engineering Technology". The Engineering program was sponsored by a scholarship provided by the University of Maine Pulp and Paper Foundation. It required four weeks of the summer from July 14 to August 8. During the first week, I was given a course in Computer Programming with FORTRAN IV. The second and third weeks consisted of a research project I did on Flat-Plate Air Solar Collectors. The fourth and final week of the program consisted of research done in improving a facet of the paper making process. The course carried a credit of three semester hours towards college graduation.



Jackson Lab

Last summer, I, John Coco, participated in the program for precollege students at the Jackson Laboratory, in Bar Harbor, Me. I learned through first-hand experience about the day to day life of professional scientists. During the first three weeks I researched previous work in the area of rabbit opthalmology and designed a project of my own. The next five weeks were spent learning lab techniques and collecting data from my experiment. In my remaining two weeks, I organized, analyzed, and communicated my results in a written paper and in the form of an oral presentation which was given before the scientists and other students at the laboratory. The results of my research refute those of other biologists in this field, and are, at present, being published in a scientific journal of Opthalmology.




