

Build Dakota is a new scholarship program created through a \$50 million dollar investment in South Dakota's young people, funded by a generous \$25 million donation from T. Denny Sanford and a \$25 million contribution by Gov. Dennis Daugaard from the South Dakota Future Fund.

Students must meet all Build Dakota Scholarship requirements and agree to work in South Dakota for three years following graduation from the scholarship supported technical institute. Visit www.builddakotascholarships.com for more information.

Students may only use the scholarship at any one of South Dakota's four technical institutes:

- Lake Area Technical Institute
- Mitchell Technical Institute
- Southeast Technical Institute
- Western Dakota Technical Institute



The Dakota Corps Scholarship for high school students in South Dakota provides full tuition and generally —applicable fees to selected qualified applicants in critical need occupations. The occupations are:

Teaching K-12 foreign language in a public, private or parochial school.

Teaching K-12 special education in a public, private or parochial school.

Teaching high school math or science in a public, private or parochial school.

Teaching high school career and technical education in a public, private or parochial school.

Working as a Registered Nurse.

Working as an Accountant/Auditor.

Working as an Engineer (includes all fields EXCEPT mining).

Working in Information Technology.
