### IAR (Illinois Assessment of Readiness) and ISA (Illinois Science Assessment) Testing

We would like to remind parents that IAR testing begins April 6<sup>th</sup> and continues through April 30th for students in third-eighth grade. We have 4 weeks available as our testing window. This allows us to insure there is plenty of time to schedule all computer-based testing sessions and any makeup sessions. All students in grades 3-8 will be testing on computers this year, and we hope to have the majority of tests completed by April 24th. Extra time may be needed beyond this for make-up testing sessions. All tests must be completed by April 30<sup>th</sup>. Please encourage your child to work to the best of their ability during the testing process.

Attendance is extremely important during this time, but students who are too ill to attend school should remain home in order to recover. Students who miss test sessions have to make them up and are pulled from classes
