Students who will attend the after school program will be provided a snack, which they will eat in their classroom. At 3:15 they will go to the area where their program is located. The programs run from 3:15 – 4:15. Behavior expectations are below. **Failure to follow the expectations can lead to removal from the After - School program.**

Spaces are limited. There will be more After-School programs offered later in the spring. For this session, programs are on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.

Bus transportation (**limited space**) is available for students living in or around the following neighborhoods: 7255 Post Road, Pine River Drive, King's Grant, Kingstown Crossings, Union Drive at Heritage Village, Yorktown Park and Sunshine Daycare. If your child will be riding the bus, please be sure to indicate the stop on the permission slip.

Behavior Expectations

Our Programs

Lego Club 1 with Ms. Downey – Grades 1 & 2

Students will exercise their creativity and problem-solving skills as they complete a new challenge each week. Ms. Downey will lead this fun, interactive club that will help students to think in three dimensions. This class is limited to 14.

Lego Club 1 – **Tuesday** – Dates: **February 28, March 7, 14, 21, 28, April 4**

Skill Squad with Ms. Annicelli – Grades 1 & 2

Be ready to work on early math and reading skills! We will work on boosting all our math and reading strategies once a week through a multitude of activities! We will be focusing on counting forwards and backwards, adding, subtracting, working on heart words, rhyming, tapping our words, and identifying letter sounds. Class is limited to 12 students.

Bookworms Book Club with Ms. Johnson - Grades 3 through 5

Do you have a child who loves to read? As a group, students will read along with the teacher and discuss characters, setting, problem, solution, vocabulary and answer questions as a club. The book will be left with the teacher for each club meeting. There will be a final craft/snack created for the book and at the end of the program, the students can keep the book!
