Extended School Year Summer Therapist positions are available. This program services North Kingstown students, from Prek- Grade 12, who have a current Individualized Education Plan and have showcased regression or emerging skills throughout the academic year. Some students will have classroom placements, but others will be attending solely for walk-in services.

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Implement and monitor the delivery of related services as outlined in the IEP.
- Maintain and interpret data related to monitoring student progress.
- Produce necessary adaptations of materials for students in collaboration with other related service providers (Sped teacher, SLP, OT, PT).
- Completion of an end of summer progress report for each student in the ESY program assigned to your caseload.
