Extended School Year Summer Special Education Teacher Assistant positions are available. This program services North Kingstown students, from Prek- Grade 12, who have a current Individualized Education Plan and have showcased regression or emerging skills throughout the academic year. English Language Arts (reading decoding/fluency, comprehension, and writing) and Mathematics will be addressed.

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Work with individual students or small groups of students to reinforce learning of material or skills initially introduced by the teacher.
- Assist the teacher in the classroom in the review, make-up, or continuous learning activities for students or small groups of students.
- Assist the teacher in maintaining a safe and orderly learning environment.
- Maintain a high level of ethical and confidentiality of information.
- Under the direction of the classroom teacher, supervise snacks, bathroom breaks, movement breaks, play periods, arrival and dismissal.
- Other duties as outlined in district TA job description.
- Other duties as assigned by ESY Coordinator or Office of PPS.
