




Q.2: How often do you talk about college in class?


Q.3: How often do you talk about jobs and careers in class?





Q.1: Is there at least one teacher or other adult in your school that you can talk to if you have a problem?




Q.2: In the event of a conflict or problem, how much do you trust that your school community will hear your side of the story and take it seriously?






Q.4: During the past 12 months, did you ever feel so sad or hopeless almost every day for two weeks or more in a row that you stopped doing some usual activities?





Q.1: How well do people at your school understand you as a person?




Q.2: How connected do you feel to the adults at your school?



Q.3: How much respect do students at your school show you?




Q.4: How much do you matter to others at this school?





Q.1: How positive or negative is the energy of the school?




Q.2: How fair or unfair are the rules for the students at this school?






Q.2: In your classes, how excited are you to participate?


Q.3: When you are not in school, how often do you talk about ideas from your classes?


Q.4: How focused are you on the activities in your classes?





Q.1: How often do your teachers take time to make sure you understand the material?



Q.2: How often do your teachers make you explain your answers?




Q.3: When you feel like giving up, how likely is it that your teachers will make you keep trying?

Q.4: Overall, how high are your teachers' expectations of you?






Q.1: If a student is bullied in school, how difficult is it for him/her to get help from an adult?







Q.1: How respectful are your teachers towards you?





Q.2: If you walked into class upset, how concerned would your teachers be?








Q.1: How much has stress interfered with your ability to participate in school in the last 30 days?


Q.2: How much has stress interfered with your activities outside of school in the last 30 days?



Q.4: If you fail at an important goal, how likely are you to try again?





Q.5: When you are working on a project that matters a lot to you, how focused can you stay when there are lots of distractions?









Q.7: How often do you remain calm, even if someone is bothering you or saying something bad?






