IMPORTANT CHANGES TO MEAL DELIVERIES

Note: This does not apply to Picuris Pueblo or to students doing in person schooling.

Starting Monday March 1, 2021 meals will no longer be delivered by buses. Meals will begin being delivered on the Districts Explorer and Suburban Vehicles.

Meal deliveries will be broken up into two different routes:

- 1. Route A will depart the School Campus between 9:30 and 9:45 a.m. traveling through Rodarte up to Llano, Santa Barbara, Casitas, Vadito, back into Penasco and down Cuchilla Road.
- 2. Route B will depart the School Campus between 9:30 and 9:45 a.m. traveling through Rio Lucio through Chamisal, El Valle, Las Trampas, and Ojo Sarco.

The Penasco Cafeteria Site Meal Pick-Up will remain open from 10-12 Monday through Thursday. No changes to the Cafeteria Site.

ATHLETICS UPDATE

Scheduled sports start dates

• Fall: February 22 (Peñasco opted out)

Winter: March 22-May 8Spring: April 5- June 19

Details

- Only schools in full hybrid can compete.
- There is a 14 day calendar acclimation period from the start of hybrid to competition. (Spring Break does not count). Therefore, we had to opt out of Fall Sports.
- Peñasco HS is scheduled to start Hybrid on March 1 start, which means a March 22 start for competition (due to Spring Break).
- No MS sports this spring.

Competition/Games

- Athletes can choose to stay remote in a hybrid and still compete.
- Scheduling of games with non-district opponents will be within the region.
- As of right now no fans allowed, this could change in the near future. We will be able to stream the games via the NFHS network.
- Athletes need to have physicals and concussion course completed before participating. Physicals and concussion course completion certificates need to be given to Athletic Coordinator Coach Mandy Montoya.
- Off season practices have already begin for Basketball. If interest contact coaches for practice times.
