From the Superintendent:

Warrior Family -

Having reasonable expectations of what life is supposed to look like helps us navigate through life. While there are many situations where the unknown causes stress in our lives, school should not be an unknown area and hopefully not an area of stress for you. I want to share my expectations for what our school should be and hopefully make school more of a known situation for you and your family.

Our school's commitment to your students:

I believe that every child can learn, and I want to make sure that every teacher believes that as well. We will give every student who walks through our doors the best possible education. We will help them grow academically and have success at school.

The most fundamental thing that students need is the ability to read. The elementary school is undergoing a massive reconstruction of how we teach reading. All of the teachers in the elementary school are enrolled in LETRS training. LETRS is a two-year college class that trains our teachers about the science of learning and the science of reading. We are doing much of this training on our virtual days. We expect that all students will be reading at grade level by the end of first grade.

Schools must be a safe place where all students feel valued, respected, and welcome. This starts at the top and moves down. It is an expectation of myself that I will treat everyone so that they feel valued, respected, and welcome. When I say everyone, I mean every student, every staff member, every parent, and every community member. I expect the administration and staff to treat others in the same manner. It is our goal to have every student also make others feel valued, respected, and welcome. This is why we spend so much time working on Social Emotional Learning and our PBIS program, and it is one way we will keep our schools safe and welcoming.

Students who graduate from Northwestern, should have the knowledge and skills to take the next step in their lives. That means our students will be prepared to go straight into the workforce, the military, or go to college. Our students will graduate from Northwestern with the ability to be successful members of society. We have a great selection of College Credit Plus classes that students can take for college credit. Additionally, we are working on expanding our careers class to include an introduction to engineering through aviation. We will be working with the Steve Staub of Staub Manufacturing and Drone Soccer Competition, the Wizards of Wright Program Manager from Wright Patterson AFB's Educational Outreach Office, and the Dayton Regional STEM Center to bring those courses to Northwestern.

As you can see, we are working hard to improve the quality of education we provide at Northwestern Local Schools, and I invite you to be a part of our success story. Please contact us if we are not meeting your expectations.


