From the Guidance Counselor's Office

This school year has flown by and it is almost time to start planning for the 2023-2024 school year. The scheduling process for the 2023-2024 school year begins January 10, 2023. Students in grades 8-11 will have two class meetings to discuss course requests and future plans. After their first meeting, students will bring home a course request form that must be signed by a parent before the second meeting. Students in grades 9-11 will also have an individual meeting with one of the Jr./Sr. High counselors in February to discuss course requests, graduation requirements, future plans, College Credit Plus, NCAA eligibility, National Honor Society, CTC and much more.
