Welcome to another school year! Every year we try to make the school year better than the previous. One of our biggest changes for this school year is how we communicate with our Warrior Parents. A few years ago, Northwestern started using a company called Apptegy to build our website, build our app for phones, and give us a platform to handle all of our communications to the public. This past spring, we partnered with Apptegy again to bring "Rooms" to the community.

Rooms is an easy way to connect with your child's teacher through the phone app.

Rooms has three main benefits for parents. 1.) We now have one app for everything Northwestern. If you have not downloaded the app, you should. The app is one of the ways we send out communications regarding District or building specific news. 2.) Rooms allows you to easily see class specific announcements. Teachers can connect their Google classroom to Rooms. Teachers will also use Rooms as their main communication tool to inform parents and students about activities, assignments, or announcements for their classes. 3.) Parents will also be able to message teachers directly. Just go to the app and click on Rooms to message your child's teachers.

We started the rollout process this past spring and already have 1,503 parents/ guardians signed up for Rooms. As we get closer to the start of the school year, we will continue to send out information about Rooms. We will also help you troubleshoot any technology issues so you can get all of the benefits of Rooms.

I am looking forward to another great start to the school year. Hopefully Rooms will make it an easier start. Let's have a great school year and Go Warriors!

# Early Childhood Program of Clark County Developmental Disabilities

The Early Childhood program of Clark County Developmental Disabilities is here to serve children from birth through 5 years of age. Early Intervention is for children, ages 0-3, who have a concern for a delay or a medical diagnosis that could result in a delay. We also are here to see children who might just be a little behind with a skill and we can help get your child caught up.

Staff are made up of Developmental Specialists and Service Coordinators. We work with the parents/caregiver in the home and build a strong foundation for development. The staff are well versed in all areas of development to be able to coach parents/caregivers for the best outcomes. Staff have access to a speech therapist, occupational therapist, vision and hearing specialist, and mental health professional should we need more intense services.

Anyone can make a referral to Early Intervention. Parents/guardians, doctors, medical providers, anyone can give us a call and we are happy to reach out to the family and see where we can help. Feel free to call us at 937-328-2680.

If your child is on an IEP and has 2 areas of concern listed as goals we can continue working with your child/family through our 3-5 program. We have 2 staff, Service and Support Administrators, who are happy to assist with locating resources that would benefit your child, help you through the beginning journey of the IEP, and many other services.

Our goal is to help get children caught up and meeting those milestones so please give us a call if you have questions.

#### TRANSPORTATION NEWS

Be sure to check out the TRANSPORTATION site on NWLS' website for specific department, routing and safety information, including FAQs, Springfield Shuttle information, 2 Hour Delay Procedures, Bus Safety Codes and much more. You can access the TRANSPORTATION site on NWLS' website by clicking on "MENU", "PROGRAMS" then "TRANSPORTATION".

Updated routing information for the 2023-24 school year (including bus numbers, driver names and estimated pick up and drop off times) will be available and posted on the TRANSPORTATION site by the end of the business day Friday, August 11th, 2023 and available at all Open Houses and Orientations.

#### NO BUS STOP LOCATION OR BUS SCHEDULING CHANGE REQUESTS WILL BE ACCEPTED DURING OPEN HOUSES OR ORIENTATIONS.

Please remember that all routing assignments including pick up and drop off times are subject to change.

As a reminder, please have your student(s) ready and waiting at their designated STOP location(s) approximately 5-10 minutes prior to their bus's estimated arrival time and ensure that they are standing a safe distance (at least 10 feet or 10 giant steps) away from the roadway/ entrance to the school bus and in plain site so the driver is able to see them upon their arrival.

SCHOOL BUS SAFETY IS A TEAM EFFORT. We can't do it without you.

#### **IMPORTANT REMINDER**

Completion and submission of the required online transportation form for the 2023-24 school year (via the OneView parent portal) is DUE ASAP or by no later than July 4th, 2023. This form is required for all families needing busing beginning the first day of school, regardless of any past year's bus assignment(s), as it provides us with the most updated information needed to maintain accurate records and helps us to ensure the safest routing for our students and most efficient routing for the district.

If no online transportation form is submitted by this deadline date, we will assume your student(s) do not require transportation and will assign them as such.

Any transportation forms submitted after July 4th, 2023 or changes made last minute may result in no guarantee of transportation beginning the first day of school.

If your student attends any other community, non-public or alternative school including GISA/ STEM and is in need of transportation, you must contact the Transportation Department ASAP or by no later than Friday, June 30th, 2023 to request our consideration for transportation. Additional documentation and/ or additional information will be requested at that time.





#### When to stop for a school bus in Ohio

On a road with fewer than four lanes, all traffic approaching a stopped school bus from either direction must stop at least 10 feet from the front or rear of the bus and remain stopped until the bus begins to move or the bus driver signals motorists to proceed.







TWO-LANE HIGHWAY WITH CENTER TURN LANE

If the bus is stopped on a street with four or more lanes, only traffic proceeding in the same direction as the bus must stop.

FOUR-LANE HIGHWAY WITH CENTER TURN LANE

Failure to stop for a school bus adds 2 points to your license in Ohio and is punishable by fines up to \$500. You must appear in court and the judge has the discretion to suspend your driver's license for up to one year. A driver who injures a pedestrian while failing to comply with school bus safety laws can face both criminal charges and civil liability. Those liabilities can include the victim's medical expenses, lost wages, rehabilitation, and non-economic damages, such as pain and suffering.

Northwestern Local Schools is committed to the location and identification of children from birth through age 21 in need of early intervention, preschool special education, or school-age services. Currently, the Northwestern Elementary Preschool Program is conducting screenings for children between the ages of 3 and 5. Screening can identify possible concerns with communication, early learning, motor skills, self-care, and social-emotional development. Upon completion of screening, if concerns are indicated with an area of development, further evaluation may be conducted to determine eligibility for special education services. If no concerns are indicated, your child will be added to our waitlist for tuition spots within the program. #### **Attention 7th Grade Parents & Guardians**

There are immunization requirements for entry to the 7th grade. All students entering the 7th grade must receive one dose of Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis) and one dose of MCV4 (meningococcal conjugate vaccine 4 strain: A-C-W-Y protection) prior to entering 7th grade. These requirements are in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 3313.671. Your child may have already had these vaccines, so please check with your healthcare provider.

Other highly recommended, routine vaccines for this age group include human papilloma virus (HPV) vaccine and Hepatitis A vaccine.

If you have any questions regarding immunizations, please

contact your healthcare provider or the Clark County
Combined Health District. An updated immunization record
must be provided to the school on entry to the 7th grade.
Failure to provide documentation of these vaccines may result
in exclusion from school until the requirement is met.
