Applications must be completed by **March 31, 2021**.

Who Qualifies for this Scholarship?

- Full time students at an accredited U.S. college or university or an ASE/NATEF Certified postsecondary automotive, heavy duty, or collision repair school
- Graduating high school seniors planning to be full time students at any of the above
- No GPA requirement

Do I have to finish the entire application at once?

- Applicants can log on later and click on the "Update Your Application" button to retrieve, update, and complete your application
- You may continue to update your application until March 31, 2021

What do I need to fill out this application?

- 1. You will be asked for a one-page essay about your career goals and you can also post an optional short video on YouTube and include the link to it on your scholarship application
- 2. You will be asked for at least one letter of reference
 - Some of the organizations that work with UAF require a reference from one of their members or your automotive instructor
- Each organization's page, located on the Scholarship Page (https://automotivescholarships.com/scholarships), has the details about their eligibility requirements
- Submit your high school transcript, and your post-secondary transcript if you are already in a post-secondary program.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

NOTE: You will need to submit your transcripts and references to complete your application. Please make sure your name is clearly on every page.
