Guidelines and Application Procedure

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING APPLICATION

- 2. Sections I, II, and III should be completed by the applicant but verified with a copy of The student's transcript and test scores. **Include a copy of your high school transcript and a copy of either your SAT or ACT composite scores.**
- 3. The applicant should attach two letters of recommendation or character reference. One letter must be from a teacher and one must be from a non-teacher.
- 4. When this application is complete it should be forwarded with the letters of Recommendation to the Giddings High School Counselor or to:
