Guidelines and Application Procedure

The Men in Mission Organization of Martin Luther Lutheran Church will offer an educational scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 to at least one graduating high school senior from Giddings High School who aspires to continue their education at the college or trade school level.

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING APPLICATION

1. All information necessary to participate in the Martin Luther Lutheran Church Men in Mission scholarship is enclosed in this packet. The Application Form should be completed by the applicant.
2. Sections I, II, and III should be completed by the applicant but verified with a copy of The student's transcript and test scores. **Include a copy of your high school transcript and a copy of either your SAT or ACT composite scores.**
3. The applicant should attach two letters of recommendation or character reference. One letter must be from a teacher and one must be from a non-teacher.
4. When this application is complete it should be forwarded with the letters of Recommendation to the Giddings High School Counselor or to:

Students must forward a copy of their Fall semester transcript to confirm good standing at their University before payment of the Spring semester's portion of the Scholarship.
