ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be currently indentured or enrolled in (or have been accepted into) a US Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship registered construction related training/apprenticeship program, technical school in a construction trade or equivalent.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant is responsible for submitting their signed and completed application form, proof of enrollment or acceptance, and financial need essay to the NAWIC Austin Chapter scholarship committee for receipt by August 16, 2020.

AWARDS

- A. NAWIC Austin will award six (6) Scholarships for the 2021-2022 Academic year. Nine (9) \$1,000
- B. The Austin NAWIC Scholarship Committee will review applications and select winners. The Committee will consider applicant's interest in construction, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and financial need. The Committee will notify all applicants of their status no later than October 1, 2021.
