Community Has Provided State-of-the-art Facility For Students and Staff

When I started as Seneca East's treasurer in 1999, the district was responsible for managing funds for the Heartland Scholarship which is presented to four seniors annually at graduation. The seed money for the scholarships came from the Heartland Communication System.


Today, thanks to generous donors within our community, our senior class is eligible for five additional scholarships for which the monies are held in district accounts. In 2009 the Wade and Maxine Benfer Scholarship was established. The monies are distributed to the school as part of the Benfer Trust and are awarded to one boy and one girl each year.

Then, in 2012, Attica Raceway began granting scholarships. Depending on the number of applicants, they award between five and eight scholarships each year. In 2015, Gary Michalkiewicz started a scholarship to honor his late wife Tammy. Again, one boy and one girl are awarded a scholarship each year. J & F began granting one scholarship each year in 2016 to a student who plans to study construction management. Most recently, in 2021, the family of Dick and Virginia Zurbuch started two scholarships. The Lucky Star Farms' Scholarship awards one agricultural scholarship and the Zurbuch Family Foundation Athletic Scholarship is given to one boy and one girl student-athlete.

I'm honored to help steward these scholarship dollars so that our students can reach their goals. In addition to the scholarship funds that are held in school district accounts, Seneca East students are able to receive scholarships from external organizations, businesses, and people in the community. Thank you to everyone who supports our students financially and otherwise.



Child Find

In accordance with federal law. Seneca East Local Schools assumes responsibility for the location, identification, and evaluation of all children birth through age 21 who reside within the Seneca East Local School District and who require special education and related services. The Special Education Department of Seneca East Local Schools coordinates this child identification process. If you know of or suspect that a child may have a disability, you may contact the Seneca East Local Schools Special Education Department at 419-426-3344 or contact the building principal to discuss these concerns and determine a course of action.

Vaccine Requirements

Seventh and twelfth grades are crucial years for vaccines. By the start of the 2022-2023 school year, seventh graders must receive the DTaP and meningitis vaccine, while twelfth graders must have a second dose of the meningitis vaccine.

Visit your family doctor, the local health department, Walmart, Kroger, Drug Mart or CVS for these important vaccines. Documentation showing that these vaccines have been given must be submitted to the school via email at aferres@se-tigers.com.

Free Meal Program Ends, SE Welcomes New Supervisor




2023 school year. The price of school lunch for grades K-5 is \$2.90 and \$3.10 for grades 6-12. Breakfast is \$1.75 for all grade levels.

You can check your child's lunch account balance at k12paymentcenter. com. This is also where you will add money to your child's account when the school year starts or you can send a check or cash to school with your student.

Everyone is encouraged to apply for free/reduced lunch for the 2022-2023 school year. If your family qualifies, this not only helps your child, but the district receives more aid from the state. You can apply beginning in July at lunchapplication.com. Hard copies will also be available at school when the offices open in August.
