Although often referred to as a "2 percent tax cap," New Yorks tax levy "cap" Tax Levy "Cap" Formula: the law each school district must follow an 8-step calculation; outlined below; to calculate its individual "tax levy limit;" That limit then determines what level of voter support is required for budget approval. level of voter support is required for budget approval.

THE BASE FORMULA

The "quantity change factor," determined by the Dept. of Taxation and Finance for each district by Feb. 1. It's the year-to-year increase in the full value of taxable real property in a school district due to physical or quantity change (e.g., new construction). Increases in full value due solely to assessment changes are not included. This factor will not be less than 1.000, even if a district sees a decrease in its full property value. The commissioner of taxation and finance is authorized to make rules/regulations that may adjust the calculation based on development on tax exempt land.

The amount of the school district's current-year tax levy necessary to pay for court orders or judgments arising out of tort actions. Applies only to the portion that exceeds 5% of the school district's total prior-year tax levy. Tax certioraries do not qualify.

This factor, which accounts for inflationary change, is limited to the lesser of 2% or the change in the consumer price index.

The highest allowable tax levy (before exclusions; see below) that a school district can propose as part of its annual budget and need only a simple majority of voters (50% + 1) to pass the budget. Each school district will calculate and report its own tax levy limit.

The total amount of property tax revenue levied by the district for the current school year, adjusted for any excess tax levy that was identified for a previous year, including any interest earned.

The amount of revenue receivable by the school district in the current school year from payments in lieu of taxes, known as PILOTs. Certain commercial property owners (usually large corporations) enter into PILOT agreements to make annual payments instead of paying property taxes for a negotiated period of time.

The amount of the school district's current-year tax lew necessary to pay for construction/renovation of capital facilities/equipment (including debt service and lease expenditures) and transportation capital debt service (e.g., bus lease/purchase). Refers only to the portion paid with local tax dollars and does not include state building or transportation aid received. *The commissioner is authorized to make rules/regulations that may provide for adjustments based on a district's share of additional budgeted capital expendutures made by a BOCES.

The amount of revenue the school district expects to receive in the coming school year from payments in lieu of taxes, or PILOTs.

If a district's current year tax levy was less than its tax levy limit, it must increase the coming year's tax levy limit by that amount or 1.5% of the current year's tax levy limit, whichever is less.

EXCLUSIONS TO BE ADDED

The law excludes certain portions at a school districts and large from the calculation above. A district can add these exclusions (described trainers) as its tax levy limit, increasing the amount of taxes the district is allowed to levy while still needing only a simple majority of voters for budget approval.

TAX LEVY TO PAY FOR SOME PENSION CONTRIBUTION COSTS

Applies only when the employer contribution rates set by the statewide pension systems (TRS and ERS) increase by more than 2 percentage points from one year to the next. Even with this exclusion, most—if not all—pension costs must be funded within a school district's tax levy limit.

TAX LEVY TO PAY FOR SOME **COURT ORDERS JUDGMENTS**

The amount of the school district's coming-year tax levy necessary to pay for court orders or judgments arising out of tort actions. Only the amount that exceeds 5% of the school district's prior-year total tax levy can be excluded from the tax levy limit. Tax certioraries cannot be excluded.

TAX LEVY TO PAY FOR SOME LOCAL CAPITAL COSTS:

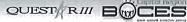
The amount of the school district's comingyear tax levy necessary to pay for construction/ renovation of capital facilities or equipment (including debt service and lease expenditures) and transportation capital debt service. This exclusion refers only to the portion paid with local tax dollars (i.e., does not include state building or transportation aid received).*

MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE TAX LEVY

The tax levy limit plus exclusions. This is the highest total tax levy that a school district can propose as part of its annual budget for which only the approval of a simple majority of voters (50% + 1) is required.

Board President Wendy Dyment called the Supplemental Business Meeting to order at 7:00 pm, led the assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Call to Order

3.0 Presentations

3.1 Guidance Department – Scott Cooper

Mr. Cooper presented on the process of creating the high school schedule. The schedule is created to provide students with the best possible schedule with the most opportunities. Mr. Cooper meets with students to discuss their future plans, interests, and class requirements. Mr. Cooper works on the process of developing the Course Description Booklet and schedules from October to June. Course selection begins in February with the Junior class.

This year, take the Jamestown Community College (JCC) Placement test has been canceled and students will be placed in college level courses based upon their grades. WACS has partnerships with JCC, SUNY College at Buffalo, Career and Technical Education (CTS), Distance Learning, College Board, and SUNY Fredonia.

Mr. Cooper asked three students to present on their high school experience at WACS. Owen Bates discussed how 9th grade presented challenges on what to take and developing a plan for his future. Mr. Bates was able to explore his interest and take college level courses for credit. He like his schedule's flexibility and balance. Mr. Bates has enough credits obtained during high school to start as a Sophomore, depending on the college he attends.

Emma Heim shared about her high school experience. She started her career at WACS in 9th grade after being home schooled for her education. Miss Heim enjoyed selecting her classes and felt she was a challenging student with her scheduling requests for Mr. Cooper. She did not want any study halls in her schedule and advanced in and out of classes. She also has enough credits obtained during high school to start as a Sophomore, depending on the college she attends.

Presentations:

Guidance Department

Kaleb Johnson moved into the District during the Summer of 2019. His schedule is simple. Mr. Johnson attends CTE because he was taking an electrical engineering program at his previous High School. Mr. Johnson has joined the Army National Guard and has been able to balance his schoolwork and fulfill his obligations with the Army National Guard. Mr. Johnson plans to attend a technical college after high school in the field of construction.

3.2 Budget Study Session #2 - Instruction, Administration, and Improvement

Mr. Corsaro reviewed the proposed 2021-2022 budget in the areas of Instruction, Administration, and Improvement. He is still reviewing the salary increases and BOCES cost in detail to ensure accuracy. Mr. Corsaro will continue to investigate the budget line by line. He will add a line item for the English as a New Language (ENL) item because there is a need. Mr. Corsaro will build the salary contracts into the budget and review retirements after March 1.

Mr. Tenamore discussed the Technology portion of the budget. He will budget for the purchasing of hardware and software, where necessary, to sustain the technology infrastructure. Mr. Tenamore highlighted the increases and services necessary to support the faculty, staff, and students.

Mr. Tenamore is looking into services provided by BOCES and will reduce where possible. He is also exploring centralized printing and the possibility of hiring a District Tech instead of contracting with BOCES. Mr. Cipolla added that the District is in the investigative stage of hiring their own computer technician. A recommendation will be made to the BOE within the next month. Mr. Corsaro added the District would review BOCES aid before making a decision.

Mrs. Webb reviewed the Special Education portion of the budget. She highlighted the current and projected caseloads. Mrs. Webb noted the increase in tuition is due to the influx of movement into and out of the district. The District currently contracts Physical Therapy services and Speech/Language Services with BOCES and they will be reviewing options to move/hire these services in-house.

Dr. Rockey reviewed the Elementary budget line by line, highlighting the increases and decreases. Dr. Rockey noted the Elementary school has a central supply to be more efficient and mindful of the supply usage.

Mr. Markham presented the increases and decreases for the Middle and High School Instructional Budget. He reviewed the assemblies' increase, which includes Honors Night, Wall of Fame, Seal of Biliteracy, and others. Teachers have made recommendations needed for equipment repair, mostly in the Music and Technology Departments. Teachers have been mindful with their requests and are only requesting the bare minimum.

Mr. Cipolla reviewed the Athletic Complex survey results, which includes the track, soccer/football field, softball, and baseball fields. The survey is still open and community members are encouraged to give feedback. The District has 358 responses to date.

Mr. Cipolla discussed programming and the diverse course load offered at WACS. He advised the MS/HS art position that has been open since September 2020 would need to be filled to continue to offer electives. The position was not filled initially due to fiscal predictions and responsibilities. The District needs to consider foresight and to plan economically for down the road. Mr. Markham has analyzed the need for the position. He recommends filling the vacancy due to the art mandates and looking at what can be provided to students. The position is already included in the budget.

Mr. Cipolla touched on the graduation rates. He suggests the District to continue to work with at-risk students and explore the option of a 5-year graduation rate. Mr. Cipolla advised the District has the right services and interventions in place.

Mr. Markham added the Art program could be the driving force for many students to come to school. The District needs to sustain the program and look for a dynamic hire to support the students.
