1. **Team Reporting**
 - a. Summer weights has concluded, and all max outs have taken place. Conditioning week has also concluded, and all Fall Sports teams will begin practice this week. Football, Volleyball, and Golf have all been IMPACT tested and all coaches have completed their online rules meetings. Five of our new coaches have completed their AED and CPR certification while all other coaches are certified for one more year. We currently have two girls out for golf from Cedar Bluffs and four from Mead. The football team is expected to have twenty-four total boys on their roster while the volleyball team will have twenty. We also have thirteen members on the 2020-21 cheerleading squad.

6. **Miscellaneous**
 - a. NSAA and NFHS has released Fall Season Guidelines, Protocols, and Rulings. The following gives schools a better idea of some slight changes, recommendations, and requirements in order to start 2020 fall sports.
 - i. Sidelined players are required to wear a mask when not on the field/court
 - ii. Cheerleaders are required to wear a mask while cheering, social distancing included.

!!!Players and Coaches will have their temperatures taken each day before practice, loading a bus, or any other form of competition.

iv. Continuing to effectively and diligently disinfect and sanitize as much as possible.

v. Sidelines, benches, and team areas are restricted to essential personnel only.

vi. Pregame and Postgame interactions will adhere to social distancing guidelines

vii. All attendees are required to wear a mask before entering the building for a volleyball game.

viii. Football game attendees will be asked to social distance, encouraged to wear a mask, but not required to wear a mask where it takes place outdoors.

ix. NO band for any fall sports

1. Football Guidelines

a. Face coverings are permissible for officials, but required for coaches, players, and game administration.

b. The team box may be extended to the 10-yard line for social distancing

c. One team captain may attend the coin toss

d. NO shaking hands following the conclusion of a game.

e. Balls will be cleaned and sanitized as much as possible during the course of play.

f. Forfeits will not be issued for COVID, replacement games are allowed if schools deem it necessary.

g. Schools are solely responsible for determining whether a scheduled game is cancelled due to a COVID 19 related issues.

h. All CB athletes will follow the same school guidelines for home and away games.

2. Volleyball Guidelines

a. Matches cancelled due to COVID 19 will be considered a "no contest."

b. No wildcard points will be awarded for a "no contest."

c. Replacement matches are permissible, but no wildcard points will be awarded.

d. Athletes not playing on the court will be required to wear a mask.

e. Coaches are required to wear a mask.

f. Social distancing and sectioned off areas in the bleachers will be in place before games.

g. Score Table is limited to essential personnel only and must wear a mask.

h. Fans will be ushered out of the gym one team at a time and asked to wait for their student outside of the building to eliminate gatherings.

i. No switching team benches/courts between sets

j. NO handshakes before or after the conclusion of the game.

k. All attendees for an "in-building" event will be required to wear a mask.

l. NO concession stands
