

# BAILEY COUNTY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION AND FIRST BANK SCHOLARSHIP

The objective of the Bailey County Electric Cooperative (BCEC) and First Bank Scholarship is to assist those individuals who desire to further their education and who desire to acquire the knowledge and skills to be better prepared to participate in the future employment marketplace.

For the 2019 fall semester, we will award scholarships to dependents of a BCEC member residing within the area and who is a graduating senior in the current year from an accredited high school that is accredited by Texas Education Agency. Recipients of the four (4) semester (two year) scholarship may use the \$1,000 award to attend any accredited university/college or trade school. Applicants must enroll as full-time students.

The application and associated documentation must be signed, completed and submitted via mail to the BCEC office at P.O. Drawer 1013, Muleshoe, Texas 79347 or in person by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 12, 2019 at the BCEC office located at 610 E. American Blvd, Muleshoe, Texas. If an applicant fails to complete the entire application or fails to submit all items in the format requested by the deadline date, the application will not be considered for the BCEC and First Bank scholarship. A headshot photo of the applicant in jpeg or other electronic form should be submitted to sbrown@bcecoop.com by the deadline.

Please note that the application must be signed by both the student applying for the scholarship and the parent/guardian of the applicant and if not signed, the application will be considered incomplete, and not considered for the scholarship.

BCEC and First Bank do not, and will not discriminate, on the basis of race, color, sex, religion or national origin or on any other basis in either the application process or in the consideration and granting of the scholarships provided by BCEC and First Bank. As a result, the scholarship for which you are applying is based upon membership with the electric cooperative of which your parent/guardian is a member.

By submitting the application package and documentation relating to the application, the applicant and his or her parent/guardian signing the application are certifying that the information submitted is true and correct and the applicant and his or her parent are agreeing to the scholarship conditions.

# BAILY COUNTY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE AND FIRST BANK SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY & PROCEDURES

Eligibility of applicants and procedures on which the Bailey County Electric Cooperative (BCEC) and First Bank scholarship applications are to be made are as follows:

- 1. Applications must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 12, 2019.
- 2. BCEC and First Bank will award scholarships of \$1,000.00 each, \$250 per semester, no later than the end of May each year.
- 3. Available to applicants whose parent or guardian live in the area and have received electric service from the BCEC for a least one (1) year.
- 4. Applicants must be a graduating senior in the current year from an accredited high school that is accredited by Texas Education Agency.
- 5. The scholarships will be awarded to students based on a need for financial help, the student exhibiting a desire to further their education, and the ability to demonstrate he/she is qualified to attend a college, university or other educational institution. Grades will be considered but will not be a deciding factor.
- 6. Recipients may choose to attend any accredited college, university, junior/community college, trade/technical school or business school.
- 7. Courses of study must be taken in credit towards a degree, certificate, diploma or license awarded by the educational institution.
- 8. The recipient must enroll on a full-time basis, with a minimum of 4 courses or 12 credit hours, at the institution selected, which full-time status must be certified by the institution with the student submitting a class schedule prior to the beginning of each semester. Failure to qualify as a full-time student will result in a forfeiture of the scholarship.
- 9. The recipient must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 and submit an official transcript of his/her grades and credits sent by their college, university or school at the end of each semester.
- 10. The scholarships are renewable up to four (4) semesters (2 years).
- 11. The scholarship will be awarded by funding \$250 of the amount of each scholarship being paid directly to the recipient at the beginning of each spring and fall semester for each of the two (2) years. BCEC will write only one check per scholarship recipient per semester. If the check is not deposited or cashed within a timely manner and the check must be voided, the check will not be reissued.
- 12. Official transcripts of the semester that you have just completed are to be submitted no later than the first Friday each January (for funding the spring semester) and the last Friday of each June (for funding the fall semester).
- 13. BCEC does not propose to limit the number of scholarships to any one school, provided the students are eligible. Distribution will be as wide as practical. Scholarships will be awarded based on funds available and the applicants' eligibility.
