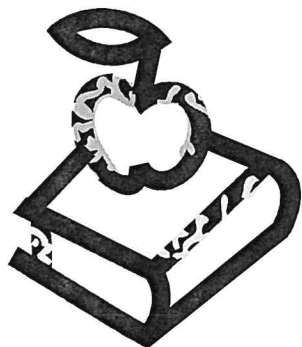

Dear Parents / Guardians,

The state of Illinois requires that students receive a complete physical exam and eye exam prior to entering Kindergarten. Summer is the perfect time to have this completed. Please remember **physical forms are due prior to students starting the 2021 school year. Students who don't have this completed will not be able to begin school.** You may turn the physical into the nurse at registration. Please review your child's immunization record with your physician to ensure that your child is up to date. Also, please be aware, the physical form is a two-sided form and has an area that is required to be completed by the parents. I cannot accept a physical until this area is completed. Physicals must be completed by a physician, an advanced practice nurse, or a physician assistant.

As a reminder, dental exams are required by the state of Illinois for students entering kindergarten, second, sixth and ninth grade. These are due to the nurse by May 15, 2022.

If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the grade school between 8am and 3pm.
