Tentative Opening of Small Cohorts at ParkSide Elementary beginning April 6th

Teachers are reaching out to parents now to invite back students to the classrooms of Consortium ParkSide Teachers. Kathy Thompson, preschool, Katya Robinson, K-2, and Maureen Osterle, 3-5. Instruction will be provided in a hybrid format, with both in-person instruction and online learning.

Once all students and families have been contacted we will reach out to schedule a Parent Safety Trainings. Parents must participate in Safety Training created to share information on how students and staff members will be kept safe and the expectations around cohort participation. There is also a parent agreement that will need to be signed before a student can return to in-person instruction.

For clarification, if a school can safely do so, a small cohort can open for in-person targeted instruction even if the county is in the purple tier. Cohorts are small targeted interventions.
