Guidelines for the LCC Prom

- 1.) The LCC Prom is not a private dance, but it is a school function. Students who decide to attend must purchase tickets by <u>Friday</u>, <u>April 21</u>, <u>2017</u>.
- 2.) LCC Prom is for LCC juniors and seniors, alumni and guests. Freshmen and sophomores from LCC or any other school ARE NOT PERMITTED TO ATTEND. Guest passes are available and must be turned in by Friday, April 21, 2017. Guests are subject to all regulations which govern the conduct of LCC students.
- 3.) Students must arrive at Prom no later than 9:00pm and for Post Prom 12:30am. No one will be permitted to enter after these times. Once a student leaves they will not be able to re-enter to either event. We feel a strong responsibility to you as parents to set limits so that your sons and daughters are where you believe them to be during the evening. If your son or daughter is not present, we will call the emergency contact on file. We thank you for your cooperation in making this a fun and safe event for the students.
- 4.)Both Prom and Post Prom will be held in the E.C. Herr Gymnasium. All school rules apply. We ask for your cooperation as students and parents to see that the following guidelines are followed:
- ♦ Students under the influence of any intoxicating beverage or drug at any LCC function are immediately suspended and liable for expulsion.
- ~Again this year there will be police officers at Prom to administer a Breathalyzer test to those students/guests suspected of being under the influence.
 - ♦ No visible tattoos
 - ♦ Piecings only in the ears

Guidelines for the LCC Prom continued

- ♦ Female dress
 - ~Dresses may be backless, as long as they are not cut below the navel.
 - ~2~piece dresses can only show 2 inches of the midriff, this includes cutouts.
 - ~Dresses may not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh. This is fingertip length.
 - ~Dresses may not be cut below the bust line.
 - ~Garments that are tight or low-cut are not acceptable.
- ♦ Male dress
 - ~Formal attire (tuxedo, dress suit, tie, bow tie, dress shirt, dress pants)
 - ~Clean shaven, and meet school guidelines regarding length and style of hair.
