Most school districts in Oklahoma were closed for the winter storm in mid-February. Many districts were only offering virtual education, so it didn't affect their instruction. Since Mangum Schools had already transitioned to in-person instruction, the laptops, wi-fi hotspots, etc. needed for virtual instruction were not distributed. As a result, we closed during the winter storm and will offer virtual instruction throughout Spring Break. Our virtual instruction will mirror that of districts who offered their instruction throughout the snow storm. Our buildings will be closed, but supplemental instruction will be provided either electronically or via packets. Because many of you, as well as our faculty and staff, will be out of town during Spring Break, assignments will not be due until March 29<sup>th</sup>. This will allow ample time following break for students who need remediation or supplemental instruction from their teachers.
