



## COVID-19 Notification to Public

This letter is to inform you that two cases of COVID-19 were identified in our district. One student at NES last on campus 03/03/2021 and one employee at NMS. While we cannot disclose the name or identifying information, we can tell you that we are confident that we have identified all of those that are designated to be "within close contact" and are taking the appropriate actions to remove those potential risks for further spread. Due to families in our district stretching across all campuses, this letter is for all families of our district.

Along with identifying those within close contact to the positive cases, NISD has also effectively disinfected all spaces affected and continues to clean and disinfect our classrooms and shared spaces, multiple times a day.

Please continue to screen yourself and your child before entering any of our NISD buildings.

\*If your student is exhibiting one or more of these symptoms, the student should be evaluated by their medical provider and not return to school. Our Epidemic Oversight Team will continuously monitor the screening process and follow up with the parent/guardian on the health status of the students. Teachers will monitor students and refer to the nurse if symptoms are present.
