The Kansas Education Enrichment Program (KEEP) provides qualifying parents and guardians with a \$1,000 award per eligible student to pay for a variety of educational goods and services.

We are excited to share with you KEEP – the Kansas Education Enrichment Program which provides students from income-qualifying households a \$1,000 to spend on eligible goods and services that promote learning and facilitate academic enrichment opportunities.

Families are invited to apply for these funds at www.keep.ks.gov. There is no cost to apply or participate in the program, and parents and guardians can enroll multiple students in the household. Current income guidelines can be found on the KEEP website.

Families can spend the funds with Qualified Education Service Providers in the online KEEP Marketplace. Approved goods and services include:

- Camps with academic subjects
- Language classes
- Instrument and Vocal lessons, including instrument purchase or rental
- Tutoring Services
- Curriculum materials, school supplies, and technology

Families that receive awards can manage their funds through the KEEP app, available in apps stores for both Android and IOS.

The program is provided by the State of Kansas and funded by the American Rescue Plan Act. Funds are limited and will be awarded on a first come, first served basis. We encourage you to visit www.keep.ks.gov to learn more about the program and apply today.
