Guidelines

Peoples Savings Bank, announces the **2021 Peoples Savings Bank Scholarship Awards Program**. Eight scholarships will be awarded, each worth \$1,000.

1. Seniors attending a high school, Public or Private in the Cities of Hermann
2. Seniors attending a high school, Public or Private in the Cities of Montgomery City, Wellsville, or Middletown
3. Seniors attending a high school, Public or Private in the Cities of New Haven
4. Seniors residing in the New Melle Fire Protection District attending a private high school or attending Francis Howell High School
5. Seniors attending or residing within the boundaries of the Wentzville Liberty High School/Fort Zumwalt West High School are eligible to apply.
6. Seniors attending a high school, Public or Private in the Cities of Troy.
7. Seniors attending a high school, Public or Private in the Cities of Bowling Green
8. Seniors attending a high school, Public or Private in the Cities of Clarksville

*Children of bank employees are eligible to apply.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

* Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.

* Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent grading system) and plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.

* Scholarship Criteria:

Applicants will be scored on all sections of the application/essay.

	Criteria	Weighted Average
1.	Career Goals	25%
2.	Financial & Personal Circumstances	15%
3.	School-Community Involvement	25%
4.	Job History	5%
5.	Essay	30%

* Scholarship funds will be paid **on May 4, 2021 to the Parent or Legal Guardian of the student**. It will be the student's or parents/guardian's responsibility to submit to the PSB Committee at that time an invoice for tuition and fees and college information. Funds can be used for books, transportation and housing as well if the student qualifies for the Missouri A+ program.

* Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor/Principal on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program. **Peoples Savings Bank strongly suggests that each high school present this opportunity to the qualifying applicants that match this program's guidelines.**

Application deadline is **April 9, 2021** by 4:00 p.m. Late applications are not accepted.

The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by a committee consisting of volunteers from Peoples Savings Bank. The scholarships will be awarded in May 2021.
