 - a. The MSBA Report was viewed. It included information on Family Engagement, the annual MSBA Conference, fall Delegate Assembly, MSBA's advocacy documents, and safety on school busses.

- g. Mr. Gray reported the "Good News Club" has been meeting at the elementary buildings the past several years. Two principals who are longer here gave them permission but it did not go thru Board approval. In order for them to continue would require Board approval. Mr. Gray reported there are three levels in which the Board could set for building use by non-profit community organizations:
 - No access to any group
 - Full access to any group
 - Limited access to a non-profit group with Board approval

Mr. Queathem made the motion for the Board to approve through, "limited access", for the "Good News Club" use the District's facilities seconded by Mrs. Muchow. The motion passed. **VOTE was 7-0**

Discussion was then held among the Board on sending home non-school sponsored information in school packets. Mr. Gray reported some schools are using a software program where parents can go in and select what type of information they wanted to receive which would then be scanned and sent to them. There was also discussion on putting a table in the vestibule of school buildings where information could be placed for parents/students to pick up. The Board asked Mr. Gray to seek legal counsel's interpretation on Policy KI, research the software possibility, and report back at the September Board meeting.

- h. The motion passed. VOTE was 5-0
- i. Mr. Gray updated the Board on the construction project. The landscaper showed up the first day of school to do some work. The splintered wood on the middle school gym floor is fixed, and they are looking for some brass plates to replace the plastic ones. The new flag pole at Montgomery City Elementary is not up yet, and he is working with a company on the east end floor at Jonesburg Elementary. The new weight room, which was the old Ag shop, is remodeled.
