## Skills Diagnostic / Placement Tests / Essentials

## Skills Diagnostic

(Language Arts \& math)
This is a series of tests used to identify weaknesses of a student. The units cover 30 specific skills.

Timeline of use:
Pre-test: 5 minutes
Lesson: 10 minutes
Re-test 5 minutes
Prescribed lessons: Usually between 4 and 8 supplemental lessons available. Each lesson could take approximately 10 minutes.

## Non-CRx mode:

The student will get the pre-test for each lesson. The student will not get lesson work or the post test. The teacher can evaluate the score for the student and then assign work accordingly.

## CRx mode:

If designated CRx --- the student will get the pre-test $1^{\text {st }}$. If they pass it they will move on to the next pre-test. If they do not meet the threshold the student will be directed to the lesson. Then the student will get the re-test after completing the daily work.

THE COURSE MUST BE DESIGNATED CRX WHEN ASSIGNING THE COURSE. The extra lessons are completed after the re-test is taken. The teacher can reassign the re-test if they wish after the extra lessons are completed.

If not designated CRx - the student will get the lesson work which they must meet the threshold. Then the student will get the re-test.

The teacher always has the option to assign extra lessons. These extra lessons would be worked on after the re-test is completed. This is true even if the teacher reassigns the re-test and the extra assignments.

## Placement Tests

(Language Arts, math, science, history)
These are a series of quizzes by subject matter per grade level. Each grade level has a series of quizzes covering specified subject matter. The teacher can have a student take any number of quizzes and evaluate the results so an appropriate placement of the student can be done.

## Essentials

(Math \& Language Arts)
These courses provide lessons and quizzes covering basic skills a district or state exit test may include for high school students. These skills were selected based on National Standards not state specific standards.
