### **Remedial Programs Offered**

#### **Grades K-5**

\*Small group Title I interventions are provided with Title I Teachers and Highly Qualified Paraprofessionals daily for 30 minutes. Student assessment data and teacher referrals are used to create priority lists for interventions based on student need. These lists are reviewed and reevaluated every 4-6 weeks.

- \*After School tutoring is provided for remediation January-April for 1 hour after school daily.
- \*Summer School is available for remediation the first three weeks of summer five days a week.
- \*Jump Start is available for incoming Kindergarten through 2nd grade students two weeks prior to the start of school.

#### Grades 6-8

\*Small group intervention instruction using Read 180, instructed by a Title I Teacher and a Highly Qualified Paraprofessional daily for 1 period. Students may rotate in or out of the class each grading period depending on student needs.

\*Summer School is available for remediation the first three weeks of summer five days a week.
