Harvard Families,

We are excited to share our *Return to School* plans for the fourth quarter!

Staff vaccinations and recent changes to state guidance about social distancing in schools have enabled us to plan for a full return as early as April 6. This letter will outline what your student's schedule will look like in the coming weeks.

March 15 – March 26: Most school schedules will remain the same over the next few weeks. All students in kindergarten through 12th grade will be in the school building in some capacity.

- All kindergarteners will be in person Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday.
- 1st-8th grade students will follow their current A/B cohort schedule.
- Beginning Monday, March 15, high school students will have the opportunity to return to the building Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday.

Beginning April 6: Beginning as early as April 6, all students who wish to return may attend in-person classes, five days a week. Classes will meet from 8:00 am - 12:30 pm.

All students (with the exception of Pre-K) will continue remote classes from 2:00-3:00 pm on Mondays/Tuesdays and Thursdays/Fridays. Students will meet in person Wednesday mornings, but there will be no remote afternoon session on Wednesdays. Washington students will follow a slightly different schedule (see below).

Families who previously selected remote learning will still have the option to switch to in-person school. If you would like to switch your child to in-person learning, please call their school. It may take a week or longer to rearrange classroom setups, transportation, food service, etc. Please be patient with staff as these adjustments are made.

As always, masks, hand-washing routines, cleaning protocols, and social distancing will continue to be mandatory throughout all of the buildings. Families will still need to complete their Daily Self-Guided Symptom Screening Checklist at home each day before school.

WEEK OF MARCH 15 AND MARCH 22

Remote students will continue instruction through Zoom. **All students** will work remotely on Wednesdays. With the exception of the high school, students will follow the same schedule as previous weeks. High school students will return to the building the week of March 15.

Pre-K

Same schedule as previous weeks. Select groups of Pre-K students meet in person Mondays and Fridays from 10:00-11:00 am.

Kindergarten

Same schedule as previous weeks. All students will have the option to meet in person.

- Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday, 8:00 am 12:30 pm all students in person
- Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday, 2:00 3:00 pm all students remote

1st - 8th Grade

Same schedule as previous weeks. **In-person** students in **A/B** Cohorts:

- Monday/Tuesday, 8:00 am 12:30 pm Cohort A will be in person
- Thursday/Friday, 8:00 am 12:30 pm Cohort B will be in person
- Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday, 2:00-3:00 pm Remote class

9th - 12th Grade

All **in-person students** have the option to return to the building. Remote students continue online classes through Zoom.

- Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday, 12:38-1:38 pm travel and lunch
- Monday/Tuesday and Thursday/Friday, 1:39-2:59 pm Remote classes

MEAL SERVICE UPDATES

Remote Students: Students who decide to remain remote for the month of April have the opportunity to **opt-in** for meal delivery. All **opt-in forms** must be completed by **Wednesday**, **March 17.**

In-Person Students: Students attending school in person do not need to opt-in for meal deliveries. Students will receive breakfast and lunch at school each day.

Bus Riders: Masks are mandatory on buses, which means food cannot be consumed on the bus at this time. Bus riders are expected to place their lunch in their backpack when they receive it. Lunches should remain in each student's backpack for the duration of their ride.
