

Prom Attire Guidelines 2021

What's ok to wear to prom?



Strapless is okay, as long as you are not showing cleavage.



Exposed back is okay, as long as the dress covers enough of the lower back that we do not see any part of butt area.



Short is okay, as long as it's at fingertip length.



2 piece dresses are OKAY as long as the gap is **2 inches or less**

Prom Attire Guidelines 2021

What's NOT ok to wear to prom?



Cut-outs that show **more than 2 inches** of stomach/ midriff are **not allowed**



Two piece dresses that **show more than 2 inches** of midriff are **not allowed**



Slits must follow the fingertip rule.



Keyhole or plunge neck lines are not okay.



Any areas of sheer fabric must adhere to the no cleavage rule, midriff rule, fingertip rule, and high enough on the lower back.
