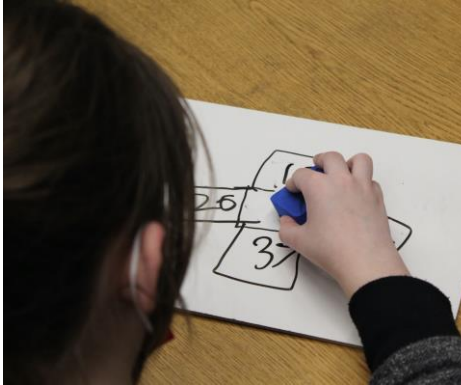

The courses are:

HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL (Students *entering* Grades 9 – 12)

EXTENDED SCHOOL YEAR (IEP Specific Grades PreK – 12)
