

Back to School Transition Tips

Adjusting to a hybrid style of learning after months of remote learning can be a challenge for many families. Starting a new style of learning on a positive note can influence children's attitude, confidence, and performance both socially and academically. Dr. Erika Geisler, a psychologist from Wilmington, DE, offers the following suggestions to make the transition smoother and easier.

- 1. Re-establish the bedtime and mealtime routines (especially breakfast). Prepare your child by talking with him or her about the benefits of school routines in terms of leaving the house and not becoming overtired or overwhelmed.
- 2. Create a family calendar to keep track of important dates. This is especially important if there is more than one child in the family.
- 3. Leave plenty of extra time. Make sure your child has plenty of time to get up, eat breakfast and prepare to leave the house for school.
- 4. Focus on the positives. They will now be able to see their friends and teachers.
- 5. Discuss how in person school will probably still be different. Students and school personnel will be wearing masks and social distancing. These concepts might be difficult for younger children to understand, so some practice at home is in order.
