Arthur CUDS #305 has developed the following protocols and expectations for varsity football games:

- Properly worn masks (mask covering the nose and mouth) are required at all times.
- All spectators must have a ticket. Admission will be taken at the gate. \$3 for adults, \$2 for senior citizens, \$2 for students.
- Social distancing must be maintained at all times by spectators that are not in the same party.
- A limited concession stand will serve prepackaged items and drinks.
- Restrooms are located behind the home bleachers.
- Varsity football games be will streamed on theroundtable.tv at: http://www.theroundtable.tv/index.html

Information for Visiting Teams:

- Prior to arrival at Arthur Lovington Atwood Hammond High School, it is an expectation that all coaches, participants, and other supporting personnel will be pre-screened for symptoms of COVID-19.
- Locker rooms will not be available for visiting teams. In case of inclement weather, shelter will be provided for visiting teams in the concession stand area or in the high school.
- Space will not be available on top of the press box for visiting team personnel.
- Visiting cheerleaders will be allowed. They will cheer on the track on the north side of the football field.
- Visiting administrators are encouraged to attend games at ALAH.

Information for Visiting Spectators:

- Tickets will be sent to the visiting school by Monday of game week.
- 70 tickets (35 pods) will be issued for visiting spectators for each varsity football game at ALAH. These tickets will be distributed by the head coach to players.
- Visiting spectators will be seated on the north side of the football field. Some pods will be in bleachers, others will be along the fence. Ticket holders along the fence may stand or bring their own chairs. Tickets will indicate whether the pod is in the grandstand or along the fence. Maximum number of spectators per pod is 2.
- Visiting spectators should enter using the north gate. Gates will open at 6:00.
- All children must be seated and/or in the presence of an adult at all times (no playing/running around)

Information for Home Spectators:

- Each football player, cheerleader, marching band member, and color guard member will receive tickets for 1 pod (2 seats per pod). Coach Jefferson, Coach Nichols, and Mr. Wood will be given tickets to distribute to members of their programs the week of the varsity home football game.
- Any ALAH HS student that is not participating in football, cheerleading, marching band, or color guard can receive a ticket from the high school office the week of the game. ALAH HS student tickets are free.
- Any remaining tickets will be offered to the Arthur Lovington Atwood Hammond community. Information will be posted on district social media outlets if tickets remain.
- Home spectators will be seated on the south side of the football field. Some pods will be in bleachers, others will be along the fence. Ticket holders along the fence may stand or bring their own chairs. Tickets will indicate whether the pod is in the grandstand or along the fence. Maximum number of spectators per pod is 2.
- Home spectators should enter using the south gate. Gates will open at 6:00.
- All children must be seated and/or in the presence of an adult at all times (no playing/running around)
