



HICKSVILLE ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIPS

The Hicksville Rotary Club offers four different scholarships. You may apply for all scholarships (as long as you qualify), but you cannot receive more than one award. Applicants may be subject to a personal interview.

1. Eulalee Hart Teegarden Scholarship

- a. Graduate or post-graduate of Hicksville High School
- b. First choice – student majoring in drama; second choice – art or music major; third choice – writing or journalism major; fourth choice – student majoring in something other than pre-law, pre-med, or pre-theology.
- c. Student must be accepted by the school of his/her choice, majoring in a discipline listed in (b).

Amount of scholarship: \$1250.00 Non-renewable.

2. Hicksville Endowment Scholarship

Eligibility requirement: Graduate or post-graduate of Hicksville High School and/or a resident of Hicksville, Farmer, Mark, or Milford Townships.

Amount of scholarship: \$1,000 per year. May be renewed for three additional years with a 3.0 accumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale. This renewal is not guaranteed, but will be considered with all other applicants. A renewal application must be submitted each year by the application deadline.

3. Hicksville Rotary Foundation Scholarship

Eligibility requirement: Hicksville High School graduate in the year of the award.

Amount of scholarship: \$1,000. Not renewable.



4. Layel and Nan Ridenour Agricultural Scholarship

Eligibility requirements:

- a. Graduate or post-graduate of Hicksville or Fairview High School
- b. Plans to pursue career in agriculture or related field (listed below)
 - Food Service
 - Recreation/Tourism
 - Veterinary Medicine
 - Agricultural Engineering
 - Environmental Sciences
 - Animal Sciences
 - Forestry
 - Crop/Horticultural Sciences
 - Sustainable Resource Management
 - Agricultural Economics
 - Fisheries/Wildlife Management
 - Environmental Interpretation
 - Plant Health Management
 - Medicine/Law
 - Agricultural and Environmental Communications/Education
- c. Good moral character
- d. Has economic need
- e. Extra-curricular activity participation

Amount of scholarship: \$2,500.00. May be renewed for three additional years. This renewal is not guaranteed, but will be considered with all other applicants. A renewal application must be submitted each year by the application deadline.
