

PARK COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT #6
Special Board Meeting
March 11, 2021

The Board of Education of Park County School District #6 met March 11, 2021 at 12:15 p.m. in the Westside Annex Board Room. Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present: Stefanie Bell, Jessica Case, Tom Keegan, Brandi Nelson, Cathy Roes, Karen Schipfmann and Sheri Schutzman. Administrators present: Peg Monteith, Kelly Merager and Patrick Couture. School District Attorneys: Scott Kolpitcke and Carter Reed.

Chair Nelson called for approval of the agenda.

On motion by Tom Keegan, seconded by Stefanie Bell and carried, the agenda was approved.

The purpose of the special meeting was to address a request for expulsion of the student named in Docket File 2020-2021-02.

On motion by Tom Keegan, seconded by Karen Schipfmann and carried, the meeting moved into executive session at 12:16 p.m.

Mr. Merager and Mr. Couture gave an overview of the violation of the policies pertaining to the infractions resulting in the recommendation for expulsion. Superintendent Monteith shared that she had reviewed the recommendation and was in support.

The parent of the student named in Docket File 2020-2021-02 also gave testimony on the student's behalf.

The board moved to deliberate on the recommendation at 12:50 p.m.

On motion by Tom Keegan, seconded by Karen Schipfmann and carried, the regular meeting resumed at 1:14 p.m.

Tom Keegan moved to accept the recommendation of the administration to expel the student named in Docket File 2020-2021-02 until January 7, 2022 for behavior contrary to the welfare and safety of other students, but the student and parent may petition the board to shorten the length of expulsion if the student makes adequate progress. Stefanie Bell seconded. Motion carried.

On motion by Stefanie Bell, seconded by Cathy Roes and carried, the meeting was adjourned at 1:15 p.m.
